DOES OCCLUSION MATTER? Part II



The subject of OCCLUSION has had both a controversial and confusing legacy. Looking back over the past hundred years, occlusion seemed to gain popularity and preeminence from the 1950's to the mid 1970's, appeared to be de-emphasized in the period of the 1980's to 1990's and once again enjoys a resurgence in interest. This rather "checkered" history is not just of a series of fads, but in reality, a result of what was known (or thought to be known) about the subject over the years.

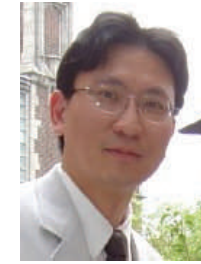

The hands -on course will include:

1. Posterior bite collapse case (you will need an articulator for the hands-on course)
2. How to apply Modified Hawley Bite plane
3. How to decide patient's VDO with/without Modified Hawley Bite plane
4. How much should dentist retract patient's lower and upper anterior teeth.
5. How to predict the future implants site, in order to place implant and use as the anchorage of orthodontic therapy (refer to the last case in Dr. Weisgold's "part I" lecture)
6. Bite transfer for full arch/mouth reconstruction
7. Occlusal adjustment

Dr. Liu was Assistant Professor/Clinician Educator of Restorative Dentistry in the Department of Preventive and Restorative Sciences at The University of Pennsylvania and the Director of the Implant Dentistry course. Now he is the Course Director of Aesthetic Restoration and Implant Dentistry in the academic department of the University of Pennsylvania. He was also the recipient of the 2001, 2002, and 2004 Joseph L.T. Appleton Award for excellence in clinical instruction.
